

ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION SUNDAY 13 OCTOBER 2024

The **Oxford Half** will be returning this year on **Sunday 13 October 2024**. The event has sold out in record time with 13,000 entries, many of whom will be fundraising for local and national charities.

The route, which remains very similar to 2023, will involve road closures in your area. We are working with Oxfordshire County Council as the Highways authority and emergency services to minimise the disruption caused.

- The majority of road closures will be in operation from 08:00 on Sunday 13 Oct with the first roads reopening from 11:00. Most roads will be re-opened by 14:30.
- Broad Street (between Turl Street and Magdalen Street East) will close on Sat 12 Oct at 08:00. The rest of Broad Street, Museum Road and Parks Road (between Holywell St and South Parks Road) will then close from 18:00 on Sat 12 Oct until 18:00 on Sun 13 Oct for the installation and de-rig of the start and finish areas.
- Restricted local access will be in operation in Park Town/Norham Manor, Summertown and Marston - specific details overleaf.
- Residents within the Norham Manor (NM) CPZ will be able to park west of Banbury Road in North Oxford (NX) CPZ from Sat 12 Oct evening to Sun 13 Oct evening.
- Parking suspensions will be in place on the roads marked with Ⓡ. Advanced notices of these will be installed in the days prior, indicating where these are and exactly what times suspensions are in place.
- Advanced warning signs will be installed two weeks prior to the event to provide closure information.
- Please do allow extra time for your journey, and where possible, avoid driving in the area during the closures. If you do need your vehicle during Sun 13 Oct please consider parking on alternative roads outside of the road closures.
- Emergency service and pedestrian access will not be affected.

We are very grateful for the support of the local community and hope this advance notice helps planning around the road closures. SUMMERTOWN ACCESS POINTS

A: Access throughout: use Jackson Road to travel between Sunnymead and Cutteslowe Estate and the A40/Elsfield Way.

B: 08:00 – 09:15 and 11:45 onwards: one way access from Oakthorpe Road into Diamond Place and from Diamond Place to Thorncliffe Road. Banbury Road (between A40 and Marston Ferry Road) re-opens by 12:00.

MARSTON ACCESS POINTS

C: 08:00 – 09:30 and 12:15 onwards: access in both directions from Oxford Road into Old Marston.

D: 08:00 – 09:30 and 12:15 onwards: access from Horseman Close onto Marsh Lane southbound.

E: Access throughout: southbound only from Elsfield Road to Marsh Lane for OXSRAD Sports Centre & Dent's Close. NB. Both A40 westbound and eastbound slip roads will be closed 08:00 – 13:00.

PARK TOWN ACCESS POINTS

F: 08:00 – 09:15 and 13:00 onwards: access between Cunliffe Close and Lathbury Road.

G: Access throughout: in both directions between Thacklay Road and Rawlinson Road.

H: 08:00 – 09:15 and 11:15 onwards: access between Linton Road and Rawlinson Road.

I: Access throughout: in both directions between Charlbury Road and Linton Road.

J: 08:00 – 09:15 and 13:00 onwards: access between Park Town and Canterbury Road.

K: Access throughout: in both directions between Bradmore Road and Bevington Road (via Norham Gardens and Banbury Road). Banbury Road reopens fully by 13:30.

CITY CENTRE DIVERSION

From 08:00 to 14:30 on Sun 13 Oct, due to the closure of Parks Road, a clearly signed diversion will be in place to facilitate travel to the south and east of Oxford. The diversion will use Hythe Bridge Street (A414), Oxpens Road (A420), Abingdon Road (A4144), Donnington Bridge (B4495) and Iffley Road (A4158)
